

Course Summary:	This course will focus on fitness reports and amenability of minors to care, treatment and training programs available through facilities of the Juvenile Court. Topics include rules and case laws, transfer hearings, discretion of court, waiver of juvenile court jurisdiction, amenability issues, determining competency, presumption of unfitness, concurrent jurisdiction, CYA conditions of juvenile probation and laws impacting fitness hearings.
