Additional focus will be on recognizing initial danger signs, drug labs, when to do a room/house search or when to get backup, when and how to alarm of danger, as well as record keeping and documentation and scenarios of situations.

A) Explain how to conduct a mini risk assessment of a client. B) Identify danger signs in conducting home visits. C) Identify danger signs in recognizing drug labs. D) Identify approaches to obtaining help in case of an emergency. E) Describe areas of concern that need to be documented for record keeping.
