

Course Summary:	Our focus is specifically on enhancing officer survival during the sudden violent assault against a police officer. The 'ambush moment' must be redefined to include any sudden attack where the aggressor has ability and intention and clearly there is jeopardy. This can occur for an officer off-duty, UC, on patrol or at the jail or during prisoner handling. The sudden attack can occur anywhere, anytime and requires nothing more than the proverbial window of opportunity for the motivated resister.
